The Amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure are upon us. F.R.C.P. 34, which simply addressed “designated documents...and other data compilations” has been replaced, with concomitant rule changes to Rules 16, 26, 37, & 45, that specifically address electronically stored information (“ESI”). Greg Johnson, who was focusing on E-discovery long before it became the standard, will lead a discussion of ESI facts and issues, the federal amendments, counsels’ obligations, the parties’ obligations, cost-shifting strategies and relevant case law.
